# a lasting contribution

Gardens for Charlestown has welcomed Members and the public to our urban oasis for over forty years. Although we are a community garden, our grounds are open from dawn to dusk 365 days a year. It is a priority that our property remains an inclusive and free green space for all to enjoy. To that end, and thanks to the contributions of people like you, we completed the first phase of our major infrastructure project in the Fall of 2022.

Last month we entered the second phase of that project to replace the deteriorating timbers on GfC's property. This second phase was made possible by grants we received from the Edward Ingersol Browne Fund and through the Community Preservation Act as well as contributions from our friends and neighbors.

- allow us to provide pollinators (including our honey bees and monarch butterflies) a safe haven

### green space

Our little corner of the neighborhood is an important refuge in the city. The border gardens--as well as the common areas throughout GfC--are maintained by volunteers, who use their time and efforts to keep these spaces beautiful in every season.



## community engagement

Not only does our green space function as a public park, but we host important community events such as the bi-annual Garden Tour of Historic Charlestown as well as Lobster in the Gardens and our Halloween festivities. We also look to support the efforts of other local non-profit organizations such as the Boston Waterfront Coalition, the Warren- Prescott School Parent Association, and the John Harvard Mall Initiative.
